Since 14/12/2019 the Greek NPPO implements the new phytosanitary framework (regulations 2016/2031 and 2017/625). In Greece there are no authorized operators for the issuance of plant passports. The plant passports are issued by the regional phytosanitary services (public institutions) according to paragraph 2 of article 84 of Commission Regulation 2016/2031. A large amount of inspections and exams took place during the year 2020 for the issuance of plant passports (although we had the covid-19 situation). we can support that a good level of plant health is in place. Regarding the WPM operators, they all comply with the relevant phytosanitary legislation (relevant articles of regulation 2016/2031 and implementing regulation 2019/66).

in Greece there are no authorized operators for the issuance of plant passports. The plant passports are issued by the regional phytosanitary services (public services) according to paragraph 2 of article 84 of Commission Regulation 2016/2031. The regional phytosanitary services performed 8000 visual inspections and 6000 exams of article 87 of regulation 2016/2031.

During the official inspection for the issuance or not of plant passports by the regional phytosanitary services, 16 non-compliances were found. Six non-compliances concerned the detection of RNQPs, no passports were issued to them and the plants were destroyed. The remaining 10 were related to non-compliance with national and Community legislation (eg traceability, registry, etc.), they companies were subject to administrative sanctions (fines)
